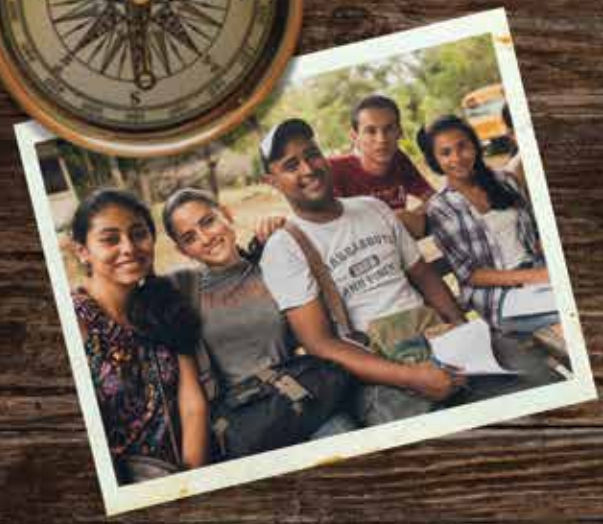

At Camino Global, we recognize the value of having a vibrant short-term missions program. We have seen God use short-term service to change lives—both of those ministered to and those going to serve. Our missionaries work closely with short-termers to provide a challenging and life-changing experience. In many cases, language study is available, and in all cases you will serve the local church in that country in very tangible ways while absorbing the culture around you.

4 weeks: June 25-July 23, 2015 (\$1,850 USD\*)  
6 weeks: June 11-July 23, 2015 (\$2,550 USD\*)  
8 weeks: May 28-July 23, 2015 (\$3,150 USD\*)

\* Please note, prices do not include airfare. Interns must purchase a multi-city ticket that goes from: home to the field; the field to Dallas, TX; Dallas, TX to home. NEXT STEP is a mandatory debrief retreat for all summer 4, 6, and 8 week interns. In order to participate in EMERGE you must make plans to attend NEXT STEP.

## SOUTH/CENTRAL MEXICO

### Community Center (Mexico City)

Join an innovative team in cross-cultural ministry, growing a new church by reaching out into the community to teach ESL, help with camps, and share the gospel.

### ESL Ministry (Puebla)

Reach out to the community as we build a young but growing church. Teach ESL. Make new friends. Minister the gospel.

### Martial Arts Ministry

Mentor youth and share Christ through self-defense and other martial arts camps and weekly classes.

## SPAIN

### Children and Youth (Southern Spain)

Work as a part of a multi-national team to conduct ESL camps and VBS outreach. Share Christ on the Camino de Santiago. Intermediate Spanish required. (Cost \$2150, \$2850, \$3350)

### International Camp Ministry (6 wks only)

Stretch yourself to lean into God. Serve with Spaniards at one of the country's best-known Christian camps, Camp Bethel. Advanced Spanish required. (June 19-July 31)

## URUGUAY/ARGENTINA

### Cross-cultural ministry

Meet new people. Invest in relationships. Serve in Montevideo and Buenos Aires as a member of a cross-cultural team and share the message of lasting hope. Intermediate level Spanish required. (Cost: \$1950, \$2750, \$3450)

## UNITED STATES

### Media Communications

Capture the unfolding of Christ's redemptive story as you serve with a ministry team. Writers, photographers, videographers wanted. Work samples required. (Cost TBD per assignment.)

## GUATEMALA

### Santiago Orphanage

Put Christ's love on display by living and serving at this beautiful bilingual home for children, located in the Mayan region.

### Casita Benjamin (6 wks only)

Model the courage and care of Jesus for kids living near the Guatemala City Dump. Help in classrooms, have fun with the kids, and serve meals. Intermediate level Spanish required.

## HONDURAS

### Penzotti Christian School (4, 6 wks only)

Teach and serve a variety of different age groups in this K-12 school. Lead Bible studies, teach ESL, and more. Intermediate level of Spanish required.

### PRODIM-Betel

Immerse yourself in cross-cultural ministry. You'll live with a Honduran family, aid in the after school program, serve meals, and invest in the students' families.

### Servant Team (Siguatepeque)

Build something awesome that will better the lives of others. Sharpen your soul by serving next to godly men and women from Honduras and the U.S.

### Coffee Shop (La Ceiba)

Baristas needed at Tazazul Coffee Shop! Serve coffee and grow faith in the communities of Honduras.

## COLOMBIA

### La Aljaba (Leticia) (8 wks only)

Serve the poor and abandoned near the Amazon. Under a Colombian mentor, share Christ with children through sports, music, crafts, ESL and more. (Canadians only. Cost: \$3775 CAD)
