InVision Mexico (Spring break 2011*)
Want to really learn about Mexican culture as you live, worship and minister with the Mexican church? Don't miss this opportunity. Emphasis is given to the building of cross-

cultural relationships. Visit cultural, religious and historical sites such as Teotihuacán (Pyramids), Mexico City zócalo, Chapultepec Castle & the Basilica of Guadalupe.

InVision Uruguay (May 24- June 1, 2011*)

Includes cultural activities, prayer walking, interviews with leaders, and an overview of ministry in Latin America with exposure to many ministries and other activities. Designed to facilitate your engagement with the culture and understanding of ministries in Uruguay.

InVision Guatemala (July 2011*)

Meet and visit over twenty different missionaries and 12 ministry sites in Guatemala. Over this 8 day period you will be exposed to a variety of cultures as well as ministry needs and what opportunities are available. Discover what your role or what your church's role may be in helping the Guatemalan church evangelize and disciple.

- 8 Week Option, May 25 - July 20: \$3,200 USD*
- 6 Week Option, June 8 - July 20: \$2,600 USD*
- 4 Week Option, June 22 - July 20: \$1,600 USD*

**price does not include airfare. Interns must purchase a multi-city ticket that takes them from: home to the field; the field to Dallas, TX; Dallas TX to home.*

Emerge Internships for Summer 2011

Guatemala, The Oasis (4, 6, 8 weeks)

Opportunities to be involved in helping in the on-site school, mentoring girls, and living Christ's love in their lives. You will live on site at The Oasis, and participate in daily life with the girls there.

Guatemala, Casita Benjamin (4, 6, 8 weeks)

Care for children in a care facility near the Guatemala City Dump. Opportunity to teach ESL, beginning basic computer skills, art, Bible, and typing. Through interaction with Guatemalan children and families, you will develop lasting relationships to impact the church. An unforgettable cross-cultural experience!

Guatemala, Santiago (4, 6, 8 weeks)

Live and serve in a beautiful Mayan village on Lake Atitlan. Serve the community through different projects using your gifts and talents. Opportunities include (but are not limited to) volunteering in a hospital, teaching ESL in schools and volunteering in local centers such as the library.

Guatemala, Patzun (6 weeks only)

Opportunities in teaching ESL, construction, and other community development projects. You will also be involved in some Vacation Bible school activities and other children's ministries. Study the culture by living with a Mayan family.

Mexico, Graphic Arts/Animation (4, 6 weeks)

Work with local designers who are using graphic art and design in ministry. Logo Design, Personality Creation, Graphic Arts illustration, Animation & Comics. Live, worship and minister with the Mexican Church.

Mexico, Ixtapaluca (4, 6, 8 weeks)

Enjoy a beautiful climate and beautiful people as you build cross cultural relationships living and ministering with the Mexican church. Activities include team development and worship, teaching ESL and kids clubs. Includes language study for 8 week option.

Mexico, Camp Koinonia (4 weeks only)

Help plan and prepare camp and participate in 3 weeks of Christian camps. Disciple and mentor Mexican children and youth through camping activities. Use your gifts and talents to help with sports, art and more!

Mexico, Community Centers – Bajio Region (4, 6 weeks)

As part of a community center, interns are involved in evangelism, discipleship, home Bible studies, music, and youth & children's ministry. This is a great opportunity for a cross cultural experience, working alongside Mexican believers and missionaries.

Dallas, TX, Inner City Hispanic Apartment Ministry (4 wks. only)

Opportunities include teaching ESL classes in both formal and individual settings, developing personal relationships, evangelism, discipleship, home Bible studies, youth and children's ministry through weekday clubs, VBS, and music.



Uruguay, The Mate Project (4, 6, 8 weeks)

This internship will facilitate missions and cultural awareness through immersion in cultural activities, as well as promote spiritual formation while developing the interns strengths through life coaching. This is a cross-cultural leadership development program. Business as missions track available as well as language study. (\$2,100; \$3,100; \$3800)

Honduras, various locations (4, 6 weeks)

Community development evangelism. Live and serve alongside local believers, helping to sustain the church's ministries and needs of daily life with work projects & micro business applications. Serve within ministries of youth, children, and college ages, as well as working to meet the needs of the community through house repairs and other related projects. Language study possible.

Honduras, Orphanages (4, 6 weeks)

Help teach, work in construction projects, and disciple orphans in a rural orphanage just outside Tegucigalpa. Enjoy interacting with other missionaries and learning about their daily lives as you live on-site.

Honduras, Video & Graphic Design (4, 6 weeks)

Help with communications for various ministries, including video and graphic design. Aid missionaries in their ministries and help promote a national Bible Seminary among its body of churches.

Honduras, Penzotti School (4, 6 weeks)

Serve in this school by teaching ESL and by participating in one-on-one discipleship with students from K-12. Learn the customs of this culture while living with a Honduran family in an urban setting.

Spain, Camp Bethel (8 weeks, end date is July 29)

Minister at one of Spain's best-known Christian camp/retreat centers, in a beautiful location, with a reputation for Bible-focused teaching and ministry. Serve alongside Spaniards as camp counselors and help set up camp in weeks prior. *Intermediate to fluent language skills required.*

Spain, Children & Youth Ministry (4 wks. \$1,800, 6 wks. \$2,800)

This ministry will include evangelism in a post-modern context through ESL. Work along side a missionary family and church ministering to kids and youth in the community and experience the culture of southern Spain. *Intermediate level Spanish required.*
