#### Uruguay – SERVE THE CITY - July 3-12, 2010

Join local believers and missionaries as part of a city wide project to reach the people of Uruguay in a practical way. Things done in the past include: passing out food, cleaning up parks, giving away school supplies, holding BBQs and organizing soccer games.

#### InVision Mexico - Spring break 2010

Want to really learn about Mexican culture as you live, worship and minister with the Mexican church? Then don't miss this opportunity. Emphasis is given to the building of cross-cultural relationships. Visit significant cultural, religious and historical sites such as Teotihuacán (Sun and Moon Pyramids), Mexico City zócalo, Chapultepec Castle & the Basilica of Guadalupe.

#### InVision Spain - November, 2010

Be exposed to the culture, needs and ministry in Spain. Meet missionaries and see their ministries first hand. Learn about the various cultures and religions that make up Spain as you seek to understand your role or your church's roll in advancing the Gospel in Spain.

#### InVision Guatemala - July 2010

Meet and visit over twenty different missionaries and 12 different ministry sites in Guatemala. Over this 8 day period you will be exposed to different cultures as well as what ministry needs are available as you discover what your roll or what your church's roll is in helping the Guatemalan church evangelize and disciple.



### Steps to Your Cross-Cultural Experience:

- Step 1** – go to [www.caminternational/pq](http://www.caminternational/pq) and fill out the Preliminary Questionnaire.
- Step 2** – Complete part two of the application.
- Step 3** – Upon approval, you will be assigned an account # with which to raise support funds.
- Step 4** – GO!
- Step 5** (Emerge summer interns only) - Attend the three-Day "Next Step" debrief retreat in Dallas

8 Week Option, May 26-July 21: \$3,100\*

6 Week Option, June 9-July 21: \$2,700\*

4 Week Option, June 23-July 21: \$1,600\*

*\*price does not include airfare. Interns must purchase a multi-city ticket that takes them from: Their home to the field; the field to Dallas, TX; Dallas TX to home. NEXT STEP is a mandatory debrief retreat in Dallas for all 4, 6, and 8 week interns.*

## Emerge Internships for Summer 2010

### **Guatemala, The Oasis** (4, 6, 8 weeks)

Opportunities to be involved in helping in the on-site school, mentoring girls, and living Christ's love in their lives. You will live on site at The Oasis, and participate in daily life with the girls there.

### **Guatemala, Casita Benjamin** (4, 6, 8 weeks)

Care for children in the community surrounding the Guatemala City Dump. Opportunity to teach ESL, beginning basic computer skills, art, Bible, and typing. Through interaction with Guatemalan children and families, you will develop lasting relationships to impact the church. An unforgettable cross-cultural experience!

### **Guatemala, Patzun** (6 weeks only)

Opportunities in teaching ESL, construction, and other community development projects. You will also be involved in some Vacation Bible school activities and other children's ministries. Study the culture by living with a Mayan family.

### **Mexico, Graphic Arts/Animation** (4, 6 weeks)

Work with local designers who are using graphic art and design in ministry. Logo Design, Personality Creation, Graphic Arts illustration, Animation & Comics. Live, worship and minister with the Mexican Church. Language study available.

### **Mexico, Ixtapaluca** (4, 6, 8 weeks)

Build cross cultural relationships as you live, worship and minister with the Mexican church. Activities include significant team worship and development times, teaching ESL and kids clubs. Includes language study for 6 and 8 week option.

### **Mexico, Camp Koinonia** (4 weeks only)

Help plan and prepare camp and participate in 3 weeks of Christian camps. Disciple and mentor young Mexican children and youth through camping activities. Use your gifts and talents to help with sports, art and more!

### **Mexico, Community Centers – Bajio Region** (4, 6 weeks)

As part of a community center, interns are involved in evangelism, discipleship, home Bible studies, music and youth & children' ministry. This is a great opportunity for a cross cultural experience,

working alongside nationals and missionaries. Language study available.



### **Montevideo, Uruguay** (6 wks only)

Be involved in relational ministry while serving at various ministry sites within and around Montevideo, working alongside national church workers and missionaries. (\$3 200)

### **Honduras – various sites**

(4, 6 weeks)

Community development evangelism. Live and serve with a local pastor, help him to sustain the church's ministries and needs of daily life with work projects & micro business applications. Serve within ministries of youth, children, and college ages, as well as working to meet the needs of the community through house repairs and other related projects.

### **Honduras, Orphanages** (4, 6 weeks)

Teach ESL, work in construction projects, and carry out discipleship with orphans in one of two locations: an urban orphanage just outside Tegucigalpa and a rural one near Siguatepeque. Learn about the daily lives of Honduran orphans as you live on-site.

### **Honduras, Video & Graphic Design** (4, 6 weeks)

Help with communications for various ministries throughout Honduras. Aid missionaries in their ministries, and help a national Bible Seminary gain exposure among the churches with video and graphic publication design.



### **Honduras, Penzotti School** (4, 6 weeks)

Serve in this K-12 school by teaching ESL and by participating in one-on-one discipleship with students. Learn the customs of this culture while living with a national family in an urban setting.

### **Dallas, TX, Hidalgo Apartment Ministry** (4 weeks only)

Teach ESL classes in both formal and individual settings. Develop personal relationships; evangelism; discipleship; home Bible studies; youth and children ministry through weekday clubs, VBS, and music.

### **Spain, Camp Bethel** (8 weeks, end date is July 30)

Minister at one of Spain's best-known Christian camp/retreat centers, with a beautiful location and reputation for Bible-focused teaching and ministry. Serve along-side nationals as camp counselors and help set up camp in weeks prior to students arrival. Intermediate language skills required.

### **Spain, Children and Youth Ministry** (4 wks. \$1,800, 6 wks. \$2,800)

Work along-side a missionary family ministering to kids and youth. Worship and minister with a Spanish church and experience the culture of southern Spain. Intermediate level Spanish required.
